### **2. Boat shipping**

Paul Francis and Gary Lee presented options regarding shipping 420's and coach boats in a 40' container. Paul has been working with Dave MacKay through Schenker - \$23,000 plus \$5,000 crantage.

Gary Lee has another deal through Mainfreight - \$28,000 less \$8,000 sponsorship. This was the chosen option. 6 x 420 teams have shown serious interest in shipping, and the remaining space would be used for 2 or 3 coach boats depending on size of RIBs..

- **Garth Goodwin and Peter Saunders to work out costs for 420 teams using container, and cost to team members utilizing coach boats and container for shipping of sails, and storage at the event.**
- **Christine to email costings to team members - on separate sheet.**
- **Caroline to contact those intending to ship, Goodwins to collect shipping fee.**
- **Christine to send out web address for Wellington Chamber of Commerce so teams can download carnet forms and prepare.**
- **Gary Lee to send out agent and shipping details for carnets to those shipping.**
- **Along with carnets, teams need to either organise a bond through their bank or make send a bond cheque to the Well Chamber of Commerce - details on carnet.**
- **Caroline has sent out an email describing the process, this is becoming urgent. Shipping details not yet confirmed.**

### 3. 420 Boat Charter

Details of 420 charter through Sports Sail Centre emailed already, also on the official web site. Contact has said the boats could be made available earlier than the stated 19th if there were enough people interested.

- Details of Simon Cooke charter boats previously emailed, considerably cheaper than official boats. Would also make available earlier if enough interest.
- Ziegelmayers could be available - contact Richard McAlister of Kiwi Yachting in AK if interested
- Nautivela (Milan) could be available - contact Nautivela through their web site if interested. Offering a deal for Garda only of 700 Euro, or 1,100 Euro for Garda and Worlds.

Lengthy discussion regarding the availability of coach boats for each course.

### 4. Coach boats

Container to take 2 or 3 coach boats - 1 to be used on women's course and open course take the remaining 1 or 2. Cost for those teams utilizing coach boats from container \$1000 per team.

Mike Bacher has chartered a coach boat from the official organisers for private use - is happy to support other women's teams on the water in return for share of fuel money, boat only available for coach Jim Maloney.

Possibly team will source another coach boat for the open fleet from the official organisers to supplement coach boats sent in container. Cost per official coach boat for 10 days charter 1500 Euro.

- **Peter Saunders contacting organisers - will email team members with outcome.**

If parents driving support boats, they need a RYA certificate

- **Roy Walmsley to make enquiries in GBR and inform the team members.**

### 5. Coaching in Greece

a. Girls crews parents voted not to take a coach to Athens. Mark Berry and Jim Maloney offering services to all women's teams.

b. Majority of open crew parents initially expressed the wish not to pay for the services of a professional coach. After some discussion it was decided to look into the possibility of using a coach already based in Europe for other coaching or sailing commitments.

Those possibly available and in Europe - Geoff Woolley possibly with youth team and sailing 470, Andrew Brown sailing Moth, Shelley Hesson in Valencia. Mark Overington another possibility.

- **Peter Saunders coming back to team with cost of coach for open fleet for a coach already based in Europe, and for one travelling from NZ. Jamie Hunt, Ian Neely possibilities.**
- **Final decision to be made on coach or no coach with open team.**

### 6. Coaching in NZ prior to departure

General discussion about coaching options and coaching expectations/objectives. Derek talking to Ian Neely who is a professional coach. Other options for coaching are sailors Geoff Woolley, Jamie Hunt, Andrew Brown. Roy Walmsley talking to Jamie Hunt. Paul Francis talking to Mark Overington.

General agreement to have a 3 day session at Takapuna over Queen's Birthday Weekend - 31 May, 1 & 2 June.

Second long weekend session 17 & 18 May prior to packing boats into container on 19 May. Will need to delay container packing by one day.

It was resolved that a request be made to the New Zealand Community Trust, for shipping expenses, for the NZ Worlds Team, at a cost excluding GST of \$21,572.31

It was resolved that a request be made to the Pelorus Trust, for Entry Fee expenses, for the New Zealand Team to attend the 420 World Championships in Athens, Greece at a cost excluding GST of \$5,533.00.

**Moved Peter Saunders/Seconded Christine Hansen / All agreed**

Any successful funds from container to be spread amongst all who put in money towards use of container for shipping of boats or other equipment, storage, use of coach boats or other equipment

A **special 420 Assn committee meeting** then agreed to pass the resolution to endorse Roy Walmsley making funding applications on behalf of the NZ 420 team. Committee members present were: Christine Hansen, Peter Saunders, Gary Lee, Phil Turner, Garth Goodwin, Mark Berry.
